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Introducing the Kensington Range

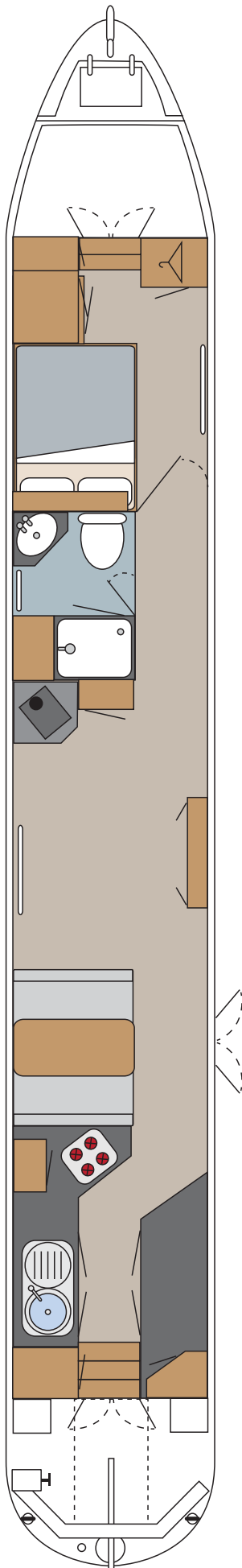

Layout

- Rear walk through galley, mid saloon with optional dinette, cabin bathroom, and forward bedroom

EXTERIOR

Steelwork

- 'Birmingham Square' Hull design (6ft 10in wide baseplate)
- Cruiser stern with rear taff rail and hardwood seat (trad & semi trad also available)
- 10mm baseplate, 6mm hull sides, 5mm cabin sides and 4mm roof
- 3 x 50mm rubbing strakes including one full length
- Self draining front & rear decks
- Quick release weed hatch
- Steel front & rear doors
- Steel side doors
- Fender eyes front, rear & side
- Centre rope ring
- Steel plank & pole rack
- 4 Anodes

Engine

- Canaline 42hp diesel engine with PRM 150 hydraulic gearbox
- Twin engine alternators (inc 175 amp for leisure batteries)

Cruising equipment

- Boarding plank
- Boat pole
- Boat hook
- Front & rear fenders
- Front & rear ropes

Exterior finish

- Two colour finish (choice) with contrast coach line and grip finish to roof, front/rear decks & front/rear gunwales
- Seven coats of paint in total
- Combination of 36" x 21" windows & 15" diameter portholes.
- Hull blacking in two-pack epoxy primer with Comastic blacking over

INTERIOR

Heating

- Diesel central heating with programmer, 3 radiators (2 on 50ft) & heated towel rail
- Twin coil hot water calorifier
- Multi fuel stove

Galley

- Storage steps with built in wine rack
- Stainless steel sink & drainer with chrome monobloc tap
- Full size gas cooker with oven, grill & 4 burner hob
- Provision for full size 12/230v fridge/freezer
- Laminate work surfaces and tiled splash backs (stone also available)
- Custom made fitted base and overhead storage units
- Breakfast bar if optional dinette not included
- Central heating radiator

Dinette (optional)

- L-shaped or raised Pulman seating arrangements, with table, converts to double bed, Storage under seating
- Seating is reclined 17 degrees from vertical and 5 degrees from horizontal for a more comfortable seating position (L-shape only)
- Central heating radiator

Saloon

- Large open plan design
- Multi fuel stove
- TV unit with aerial/satellite point
- Central heating radiator

Bathroom

- Cabin bathroom
- Cassette toilet (pump out option also available)
- 800mm x 800mm shower cubicle
- Heated towel radiator
- Ceramic basin in vanity unit with chrome mixer tap
- Wall mirror
- Shaver socket



INTERIOR CONTINUED

Bedroom

- Fixed 6' 3" x 4' 6" double bed with luxury mattress
- Over bed shelf incorporating reading lights
- Open under bed storage (restricted with pump out toilet system)
- Storage steps to rear deck
- Ample wardrobe space with optional washing machine housing
- Central heating radiator
- Washing machine housing (optional)

Interior finish

- Dense spray foam insulation (average 38mm)
- Painted cream and oak veneer ply panel to cabin sides and deck head
- Solid oak trims & edging
- Solid oak door frames throughout including cupboards
- Solid oak window surrounds
- Laminate flooring throughout (except bathroom)
- Vinyl floor covering (choice) to bathroom
- Easy clean laminate shower panel (choice)
- Chrome effect one piece window/porthole frames
- Single pane windows (glass easily removed for cleaning)
- Chrome finish to switches, sockets, down lights & mushroom vents
- Substantial bolts to exterior doors & hatches
- Please note, unlike other builders, we *never* use MDF on hull or cabin linings

Electrical

- 1 x 110 amp/h starter battery
- 5 x 110 amp/h leisure batteries
- 230v ring main circuit with 5 x 2-gang sockets & RCD protection
- 230v landline socket
- 3kW pure sine wave inverter
- 12v circuit
- Wall lights and halogen down lights
- AC/DC distribution panel
- Battery charger
- Automatic bilge pump
- Headlamp & horn
- Battery isolation switches
